

8. GUIDELINES FOR SATELLITE DISH AERIALS

WHAT TO INCLUDE IN YOUR APPLICATION

- Please provide a clear photo of the property with your application, marked with the intended location and confirmation of size.

Alternatives to satellite dishes on the market mean that the number of households requiring them is expected to diminish. If you decide to proceed with installing an external dish-style aerial, please note the following criteria which should be followed to comply with the Scheme of Management:

- The satellite dish must not be visible from the road or located above the eaves of the roof and must be unobtrusive to neighbours.
- The maximum permitted diameter is 0.6m (2ft).
- Dish aerials are not usually permitted in front gardens. If the satellite dish is unobtrusive to neighbours in the rear or side garden, this may be acceptable.
- You may be asked to paint the dish so that it blends in with its surroundings.
- Satellite dishes should be removed as soon as reasonably practicable when they are no longer needed.

If your installation does not comply with the guidelines you may be asked to relocate it, so if you need to check anything before installation please contact the Scheme of Management office. You will need to provide a clear photo of the property marked with the intended location and confirmation of the size of the dish.
